CFL PILGRIM PASSPORT

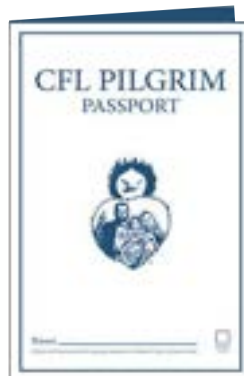
