CATHOLIC CORPS (IN RED SHIRTS)

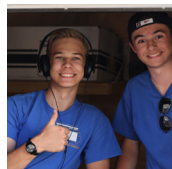
Est. 1986

Lay members of the AFC who consecrate themselves by private vows of chastity, poverty, and obedience to God and live this consecration of life in service to families through the AFC's mission.

SERVICE CORPS (IN BLUE SHIRTS)

Est. 1999

High school youth who volunteer to serve families by helping the AFC with event activities and other tasks. They minister to families while growing in their relationship with God over the course of the summer season.



ALUMNI CORPS (IN BLACK SHIRTS)

Est. 2005

Young adult missionaries who join the AFC in its mission to form families in the Catholic Faith. During their time of service to Christ and His Church, the Alumni Corps devote time to prayer, community, and formation. They lead many event activities.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

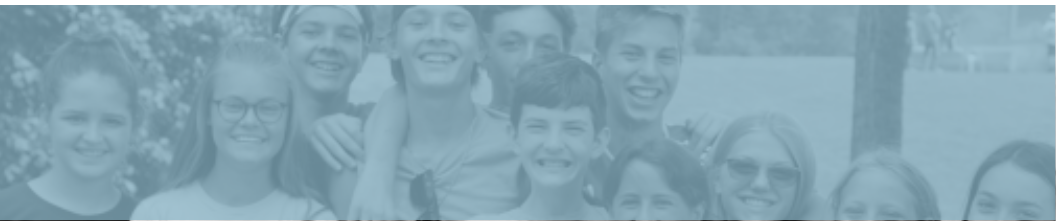
Children's Ministry (4-12 year olds)
