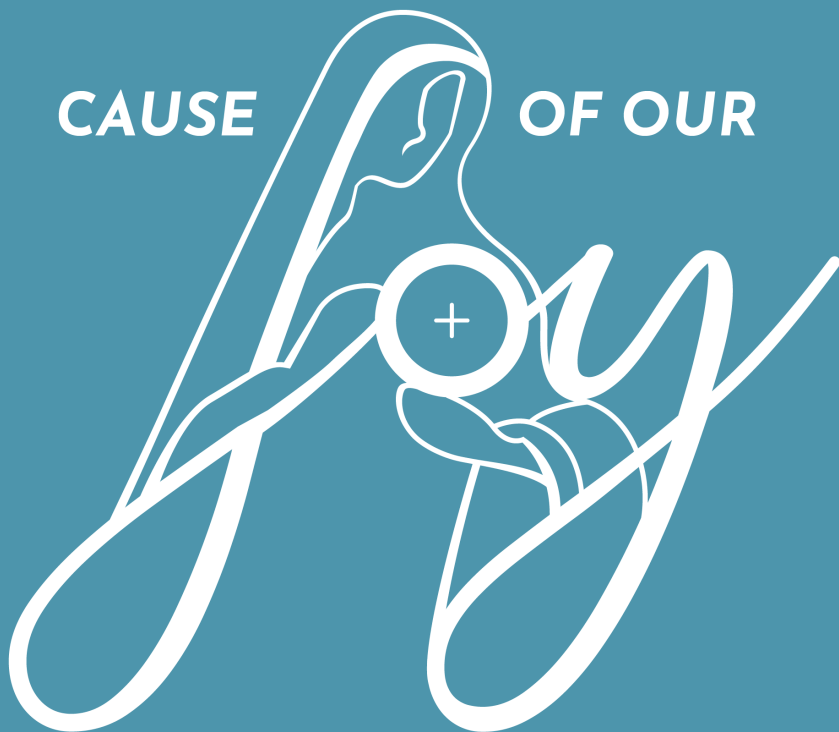

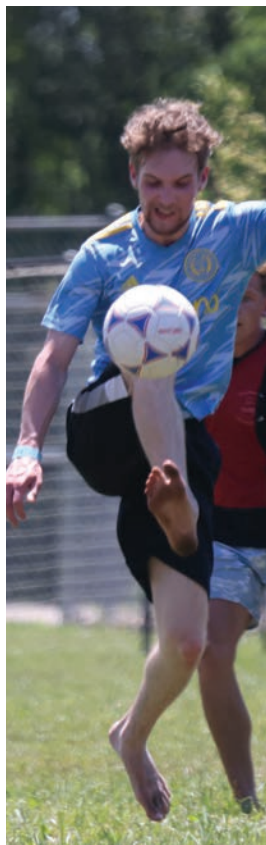

# CFL PILGRIM PASSPORT

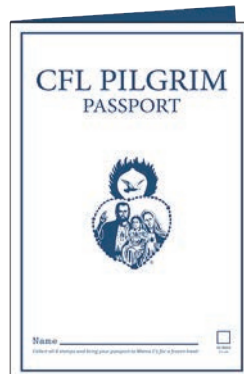
